## Message from the Chairman

The Japan Responsible Care Council (JRCC) and the Japan Chemical Industry Association (JCIA) will hold the 11th Asia Pacific Responsible Care Conference 2009 (The 11th APRCC 2009) in Tokyo from October 18 to 21, 2009. We at the JRCC and the JCIA co-hosted the 3rd APRCC in 1997 in Japan, and feel honored and proud to be the hosts again this year.

Chemical products are essential materials for a wide variety of consumer products, and with their high performance, contribute to bettering people's lives and provide comfort in everyday life. At the same time, like other products, chemical products could cause adverse effects on human health and the environment when used in an inappropriate way.

Fully recognizing these aspects of chemical products, the chemical industry has been committed to Responsible Care—the industry's voluntary initiative under which companies work together to ensure the safe use of chemical products, to continuously improve their health, safety and environmental performance, and to communicate with stakeholders about their products and processes.

The International Council of Chemical Associations (ICCA) has organized the Responsible Care Leadership Group and has led the industry's efforts to promote Responsible Care activities globally. Responsible Care is now being implemented in 53 countries and regions. It is particularly important to achieve further development of Responsible Care in the Asia Pacific, where the economy continues the highest growth in the world.

In 2006, the ICCA announced Responsible Care Global Charter and the Global Product Strategy, and demonstrated its commitment to strongly promoting Product Stewardship, the industry-wide program to achieve safer use of chemical products by conducting risk assessment for chemical products and communicating the results of the assessment throughout the value chain.

At the 11th APRCC 2009, we will hold sessions to discuss key issues for Responsible Care, as well as Product Stewardship Workshop together with the ICCA's Chemicals Policy and Health Leadership Group, with the aim of further promoting Responsible Care activities in the Asia Pacific region. At the sessions, experts will speak about Responsible Care activities in their own regions and creative programs under way at their companies. At the Product Stewardship Workshop, experts will explain the purpose of Product Stewardship and the processes of risk assessment and communication and present case studies.

We strongly believe learning from experts and networking with participants at this conference will be both worthwhile and rewarding and will help to further enhance Responsible Care in the Asia Pacific.

The APRCC, convened once every two years, is one of the most important conferences for promoting the development of Responsible Care in the region, and I sincerely hope you will take part in this significant event. I look forward to seeing you in October in Tokyo.

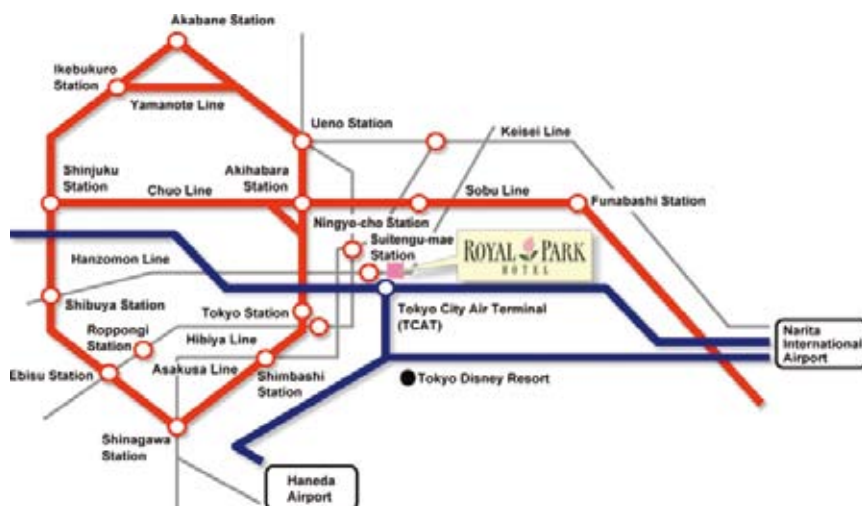

### ACCESS

The Royal Park Hotel is ideally located next door to the Tokyo City Air Terminal (TCAT) from which buses leave several times each hour for Narita International Airport, Just 60 minutes away.
